After shining on the NCBA U.S. Kids Local Tour, Hakeem earned his ticket to the U.S. Kids Golf World Championship 2025 in Pinehurst, USA, every junior golfer's dream stage.

And what a debut! Over three days, Hakeem shot rounds of 75, 75, and 77, finishing T47 out of 123 players worldwide in the Boys 9 category. Solid golf, steady nerves, and plenty of Kenyan pride.

When asked about the experience, Hakeem's highlights included: Marching with Team Kenya at the Parade of Nations. Outdriving most of his flight-mates and making new friends like Ryder, Avi, and Gabriel.Learning that precision (especially on the second shot) is the secret sauce to world-class golf.

Off the course, Hakeem still finds time for Wimpy Kid books, F1 karting, basketball, piano, and bike rides. Not bad for someone who also carries the Warriors spirit into junior golf!

What's next? Hakeem is eyeing another Pinehurst run at 11, a spot in the Kenya Junior Golf Team, and eventually the Magical Kenya Open. Big dreams, bigger drive.


A night filled with winners, music, games and member voices. That is what LCC spirit is all about!

43 Years of Grace, One Big Win for Adah









Grace, Adah, and NCBA — a winning trio on the greens






Young & Youthful Golf Tournament – Fresh Swings, Fresh Vibes
